AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LAKEWOOD, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING & SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER XX (STREETS AND SIDEWALKS), SECTION 20-1.5 (PERMIT FEES) OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF LAKEWOOD

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Committee of the Township of Lakewood, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, that Chapter XX (STREETS AND SIDEWALKS), Section 20-1.5 (Permit fees) of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of Lakewood shall be amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 20-1.5. Fees is amended and supplemented to read as follows:

20-1.5 Permit Fees. the following schedule of fees is hereby fixed, determined and established as being the fees to be paid to the Township of Lakewood to be drawn upon by the Municipal Engineer in conjunction with the issuance and servicing of such permits, and supervision and inspection of such openings to proper restoration.

- a. Openings not greater than fifty (50) feet in length, one hundred (\$100.00) dollars.
- b. Openings up to one hundred (100) feet in length, one hundred twenty-five (\$125.00) dollars.
- c. Openings up to two hundred (200) feet in length, one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars.
- d. Openings up to four hundred (400) feet in length, two hundred (\$200) dollars.
- e. Openings up to four hundred (400) feet, three hundred (\$300.00) DOLLARS, plus fifty (\$0.50) cents per lineal foot in excess of four hundred (400) feet.
- f. An administrative fee of twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars shall be added to the permit fee amount referenced above.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or any part of this Ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance not directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
