The area of the proposed amendment is Block 1160.03, Lots 42 and 43, which are located at the southwestern corner of Healthcare Way and Towbin Avenue. The Governing Body will consider a resolution approving submission of the proposed amendment to the State Plan Policy Map to the State Planning Commission.
