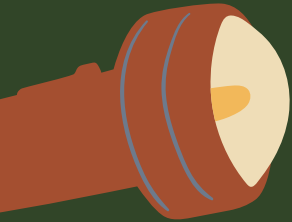

OUTDOOR FIRE SAFETY



GRILLS

Place your grill away from siding, deck railings, and out from under eaves and overhanging branches.

Keep an eye on your grill. Don't walk away from it when it is lit.

Keep a 3-foot safe zone around your grill. This will keep kids and pets safe.

CAMPFIRES

Build campfires at least 25 feet away from tents, shrubs and anything that can burn.

Turn off or put out fires before you leave the backyard.

Watch children when the fire pit is in use. Store matches and lighters out of children's sight & reach.

DID YOU KNOW:

Sparklers can reach **1,200 degrees F** and cause 3rd-degree burns.
